DELEGATE QUALIFICATIONS: Delegate must be a high school student in good standing (to enter Grades 10th – 12th in the 2014 year or just completed Senior Year, but in no event over the age of 18 years, and must turn 15 years old by 9/1/14), must have demonstrated leadership qualities, must have sense of personal responsibility in their school, church and community service, are interested in discovering their natural leadership abilities, developing their leadership skills, and improving the capacity for taking effective action individually and in groups, and must have good academic standing.
